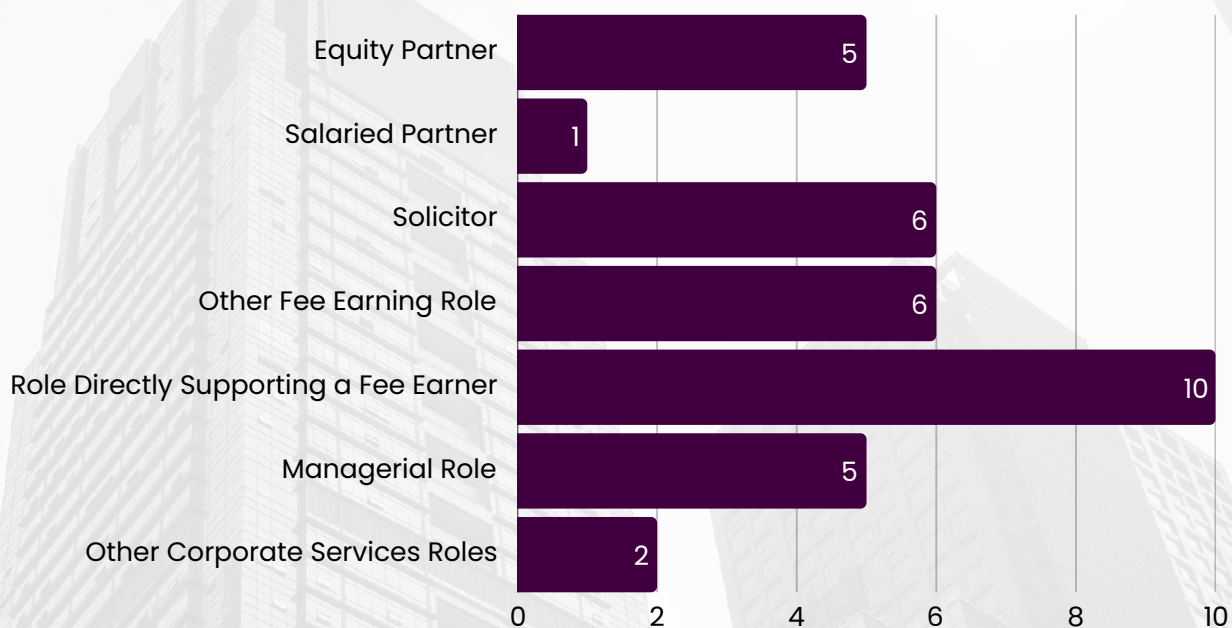

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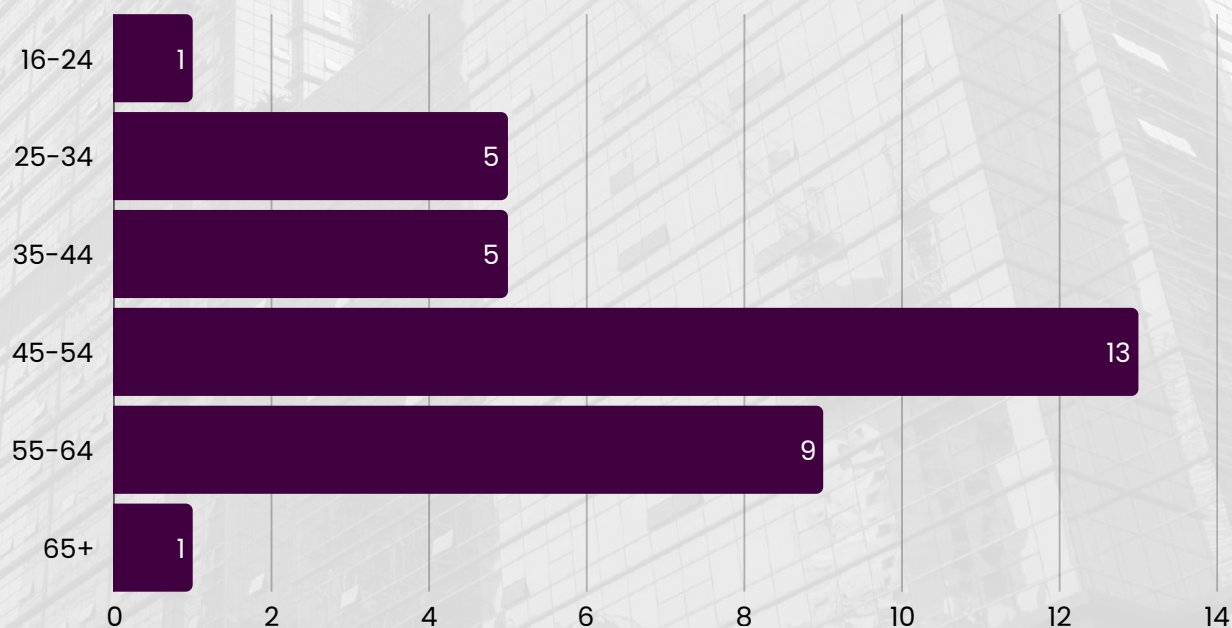
Solicitors Regulation Authority Diversity Data Survey Results 2025

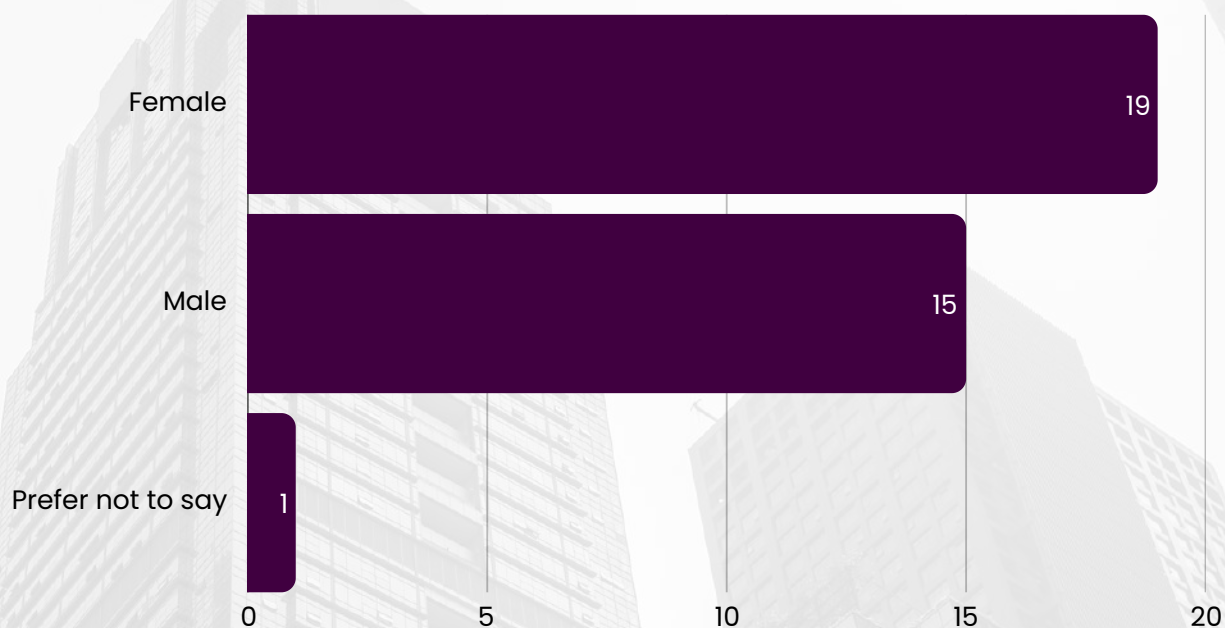
Q1 Select one category which best describes your role in the firm.



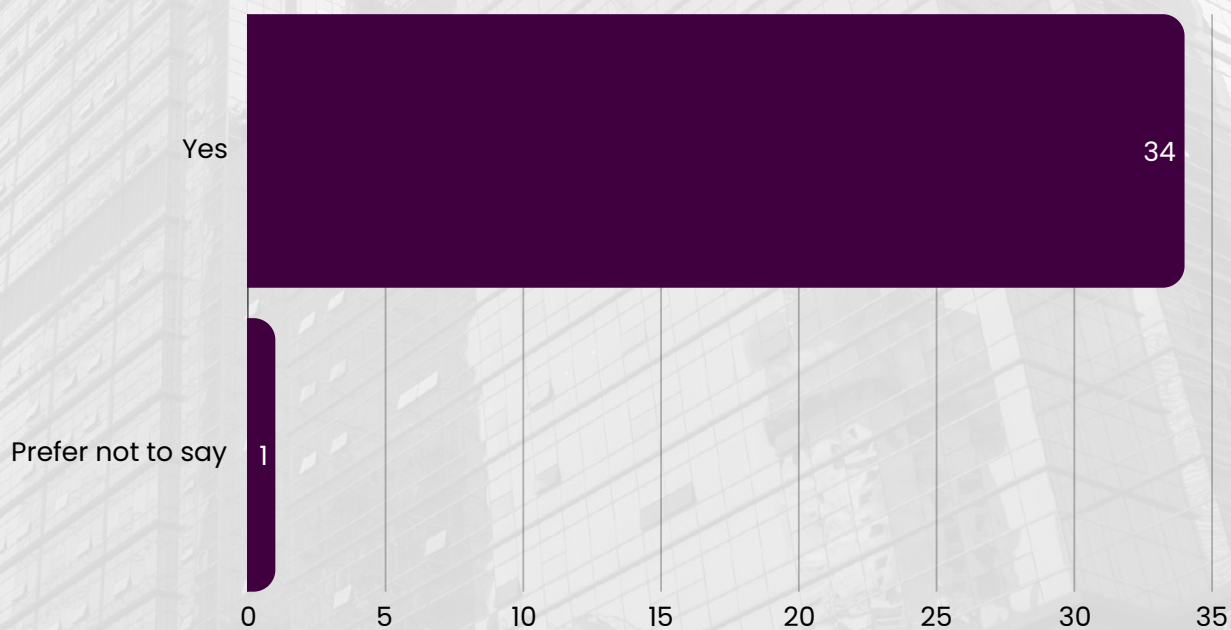
Q2 What age category are you in?



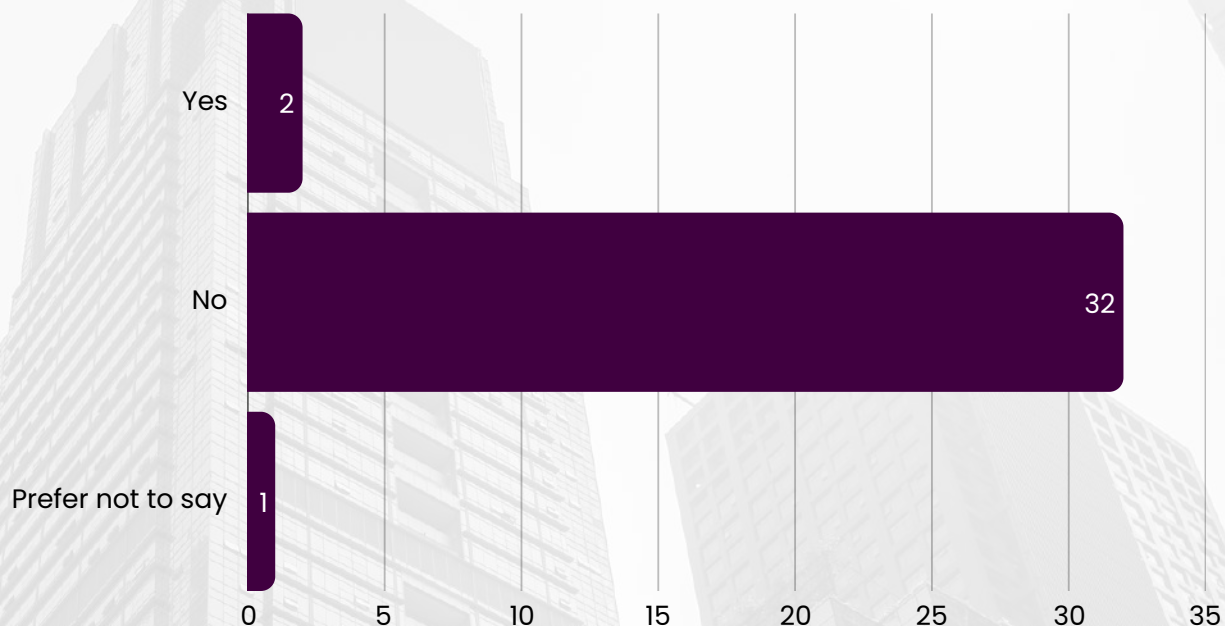
Q3 What is your sex?



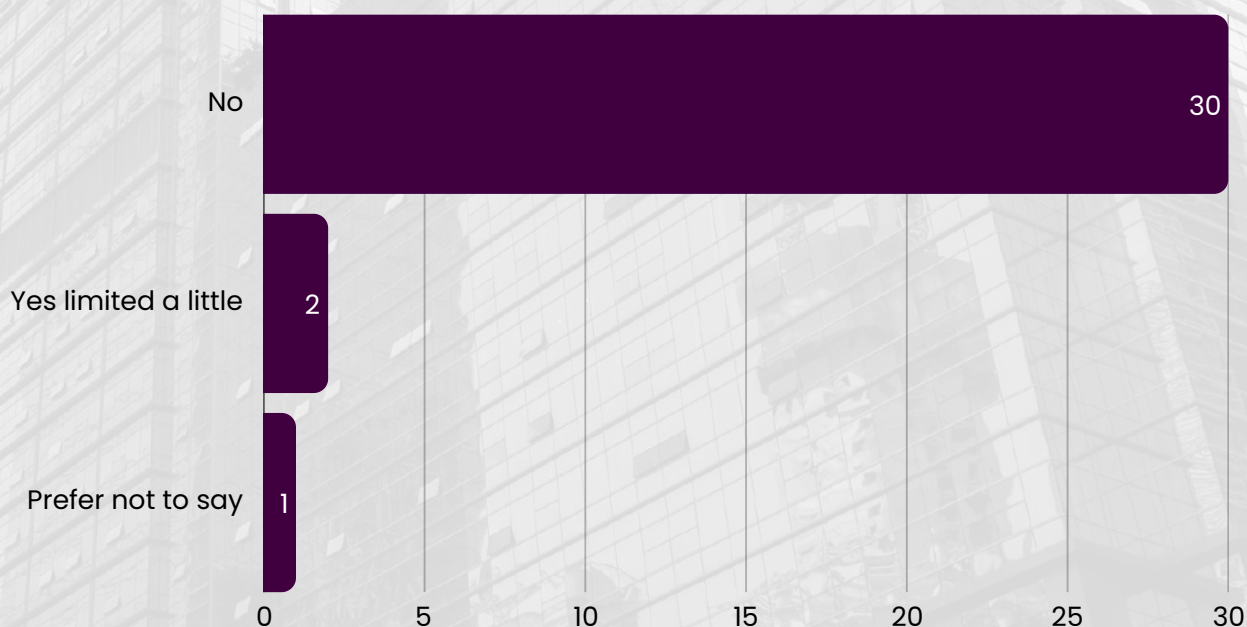
Q4 Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?



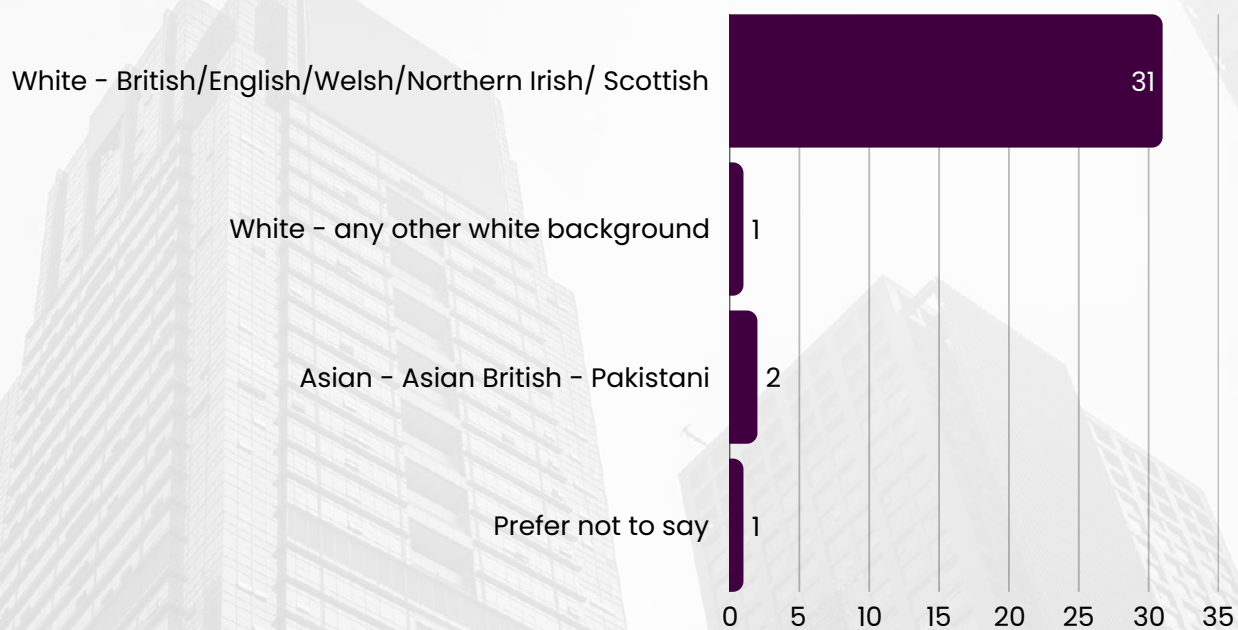
Q5 Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act 2010?



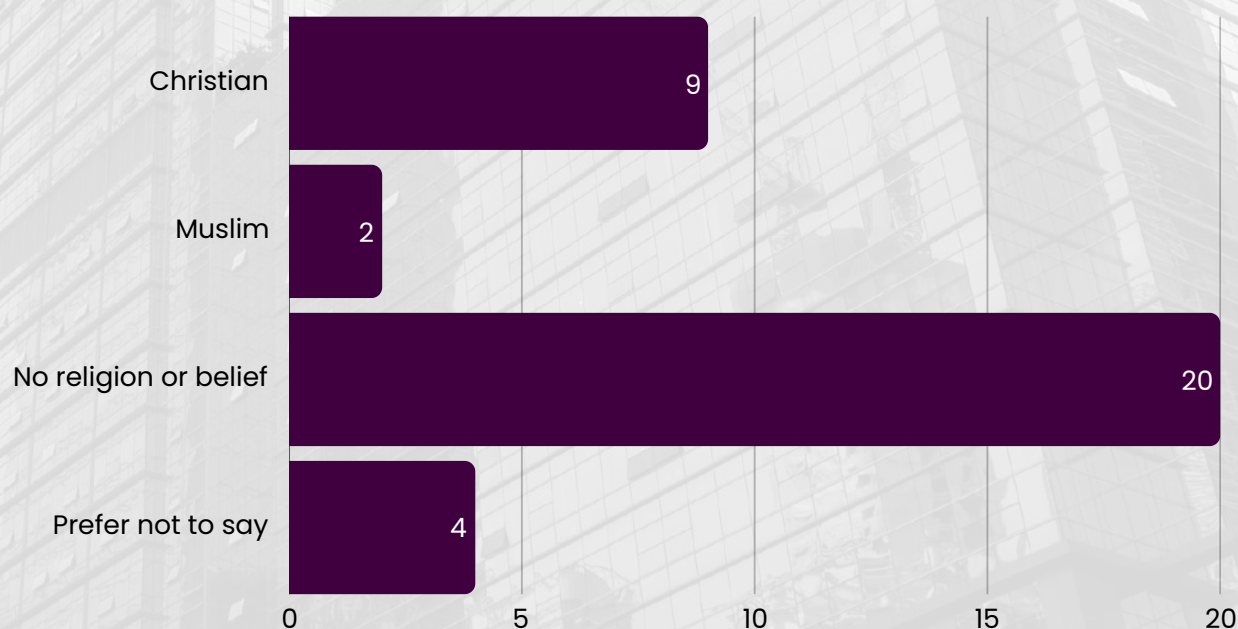
Q6 Are you day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?



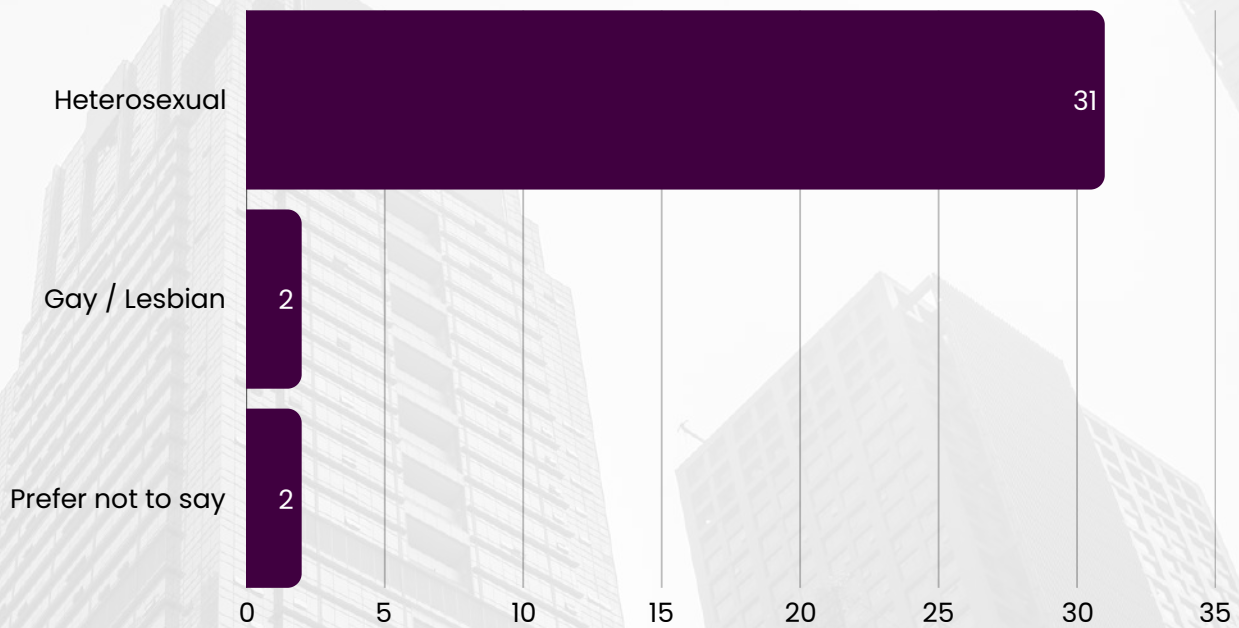
Q7 What is your ethnic group?



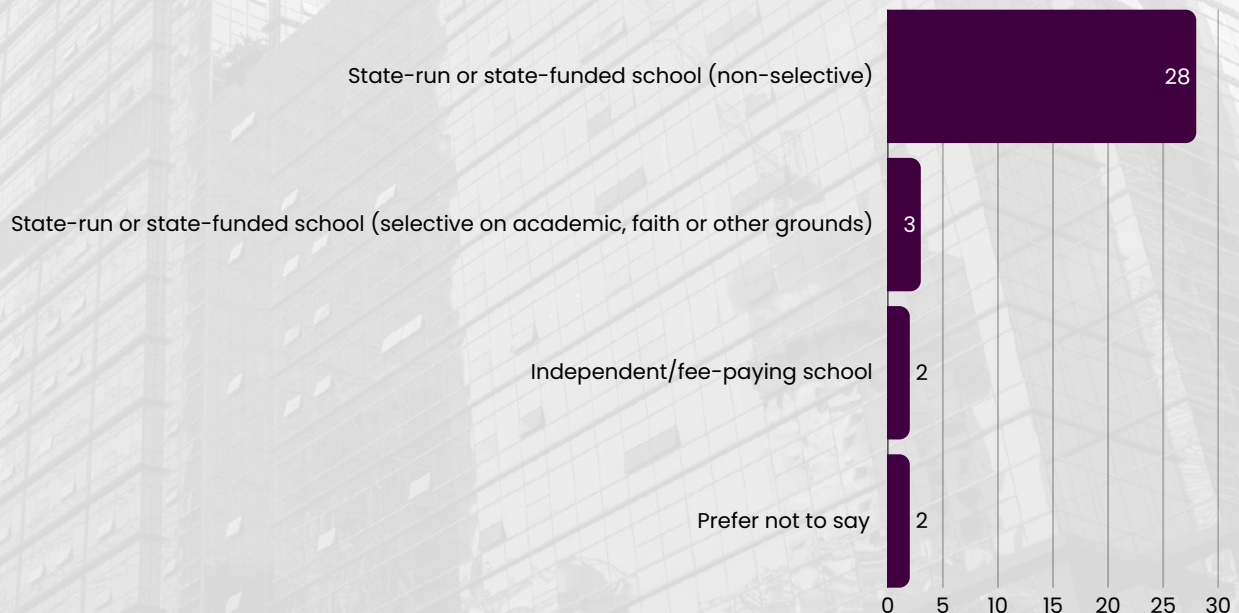
Q8 What is your religion or belief?



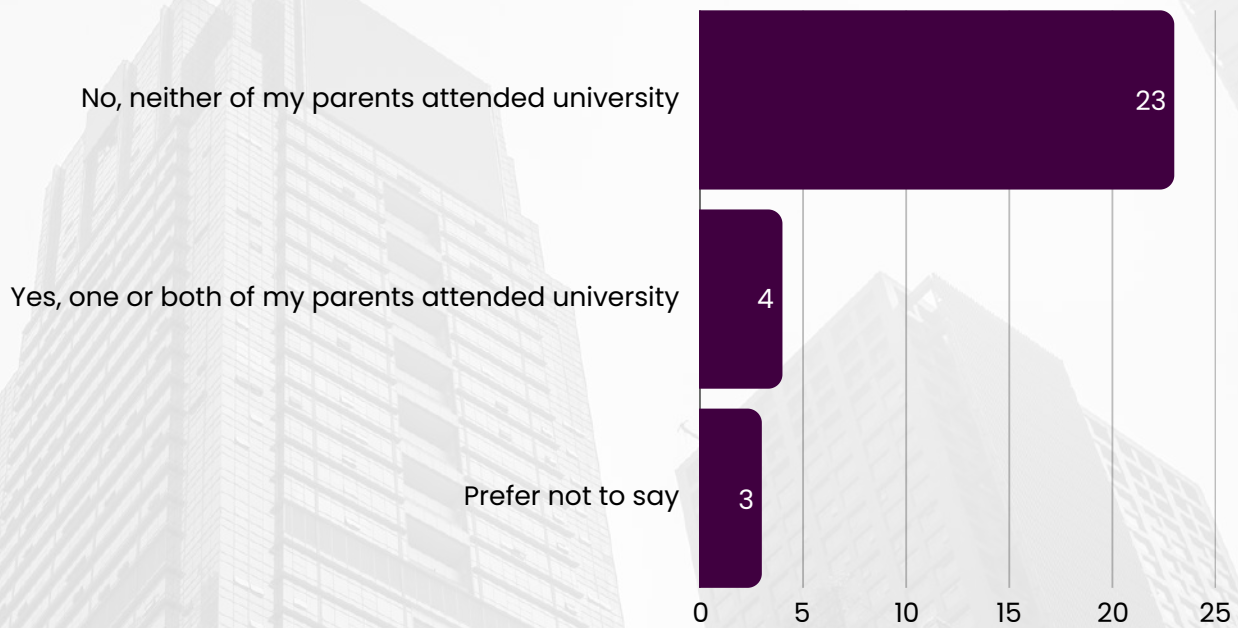
Q9 What is your sexual orientation?



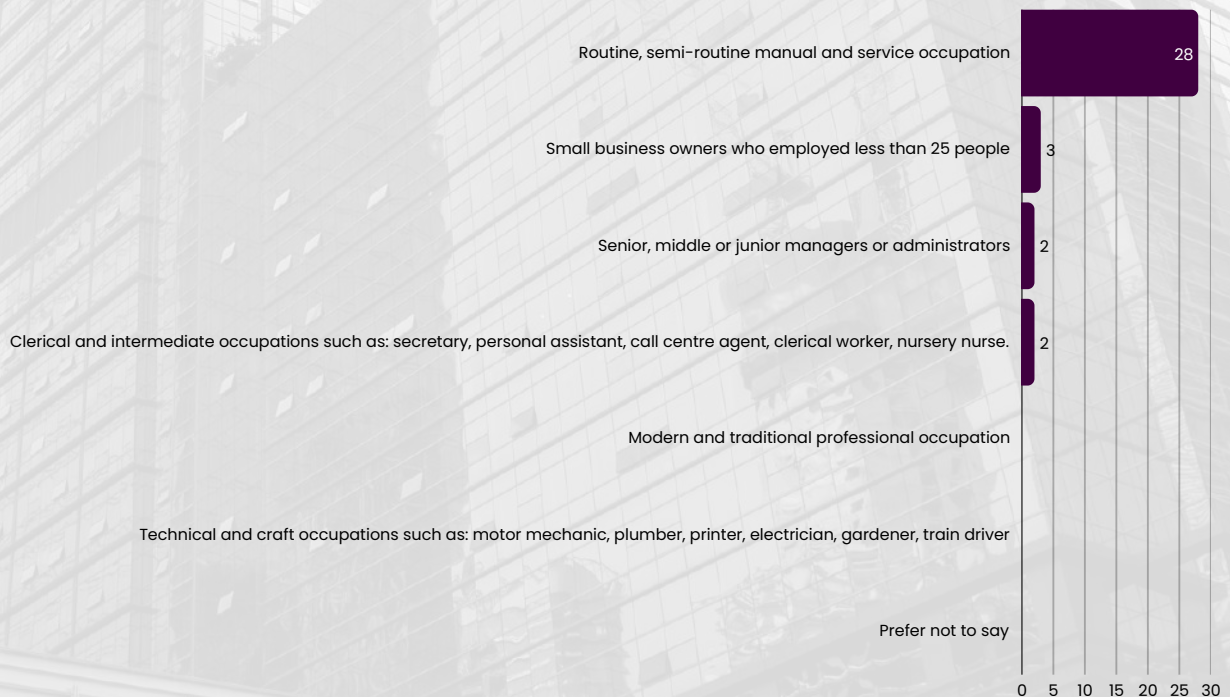
Q10 What type of school did you mainly attend between the ages 11– 16? (if you changed schools, please base your answer on the last two years of your education)



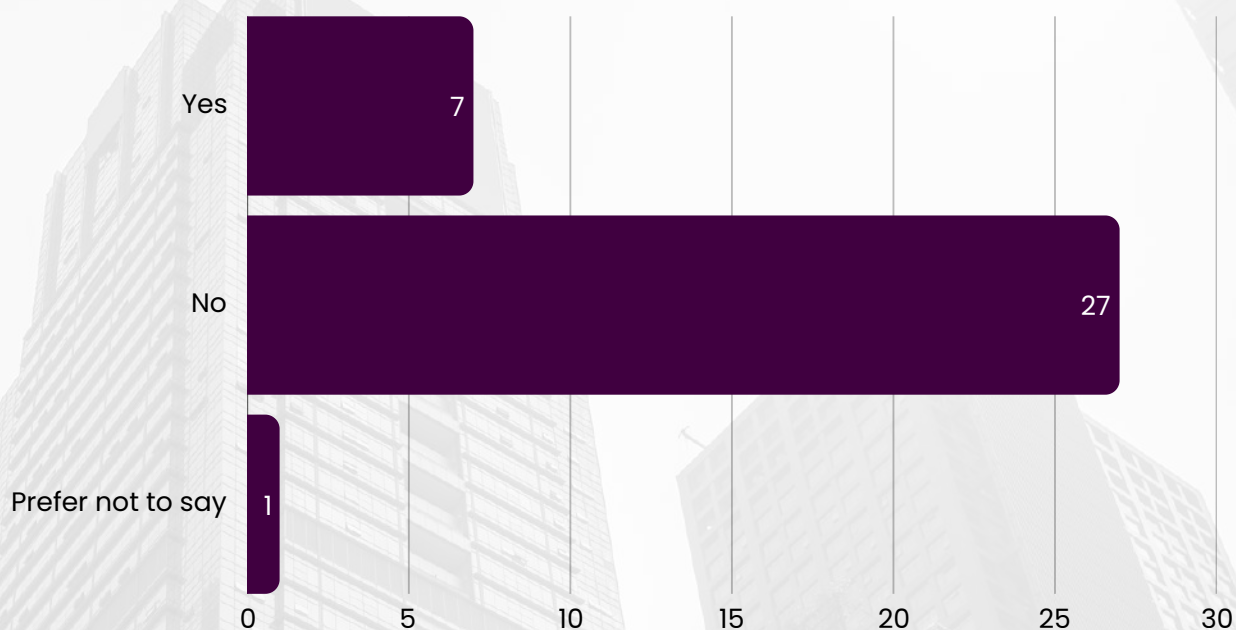
Q11 Did either of your parents attend university by the time you were 18?



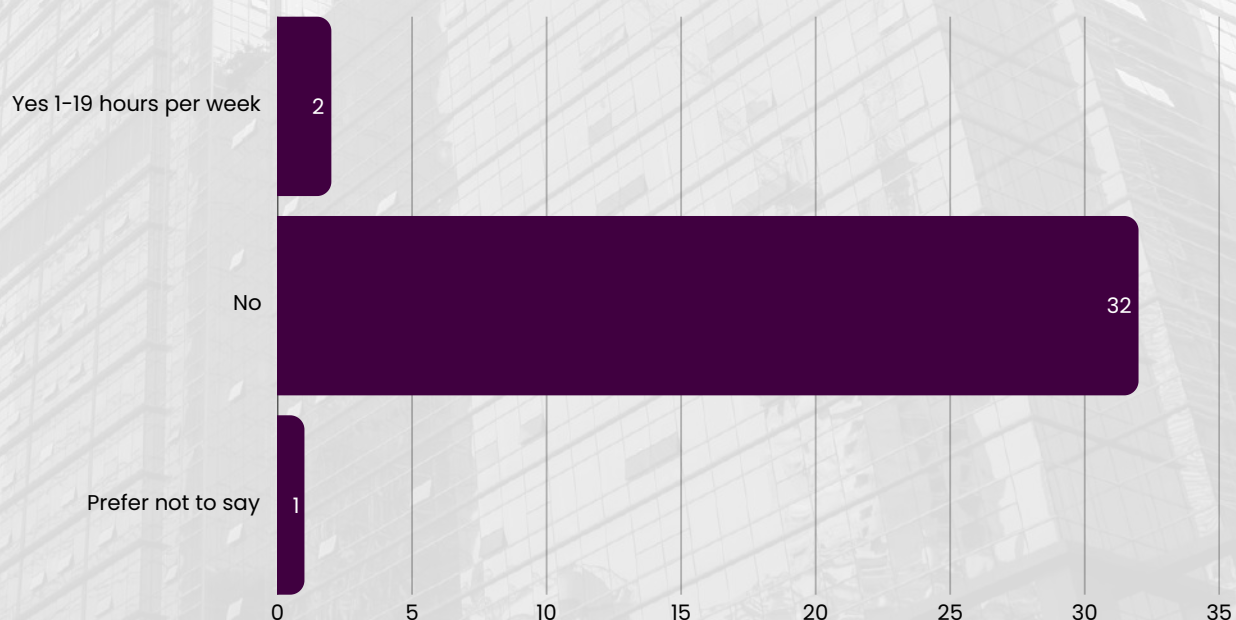
Q12 What was the occupation of your main household earner when you were about 14?
